Planned Additions

- Amusement Park
- Salena Amphitheater
 - 3,500 Seats
 - Grass seating with views of the entertainment district
- Public Art
 - Art installations
 - Military service memorial
 - 40-foot Tony Amos Memorial Dolphin Fountain by Kent Ullberg
- Ferry Tours
 - 15-minute Canal Ride
 - 45-minute Island Nature Tour
- Sports Venues
 - 2 Regulation Soccer Fields
 - 2 Softball Fields
 - Beach Volley Ball
 - Water Volley Ball
- Water Taxi
 - Taxi between downtown Corpus Christi, the Texas State Aquarium, and the Entertainment District
- Bird Islands
 - 10 islands
 - 8 islands designated exclusively as habitat

Infrastructure

- Canal Construction
 - 10- feet deep in the center of the canal
 - 62-feet wide at its narrowest point
 - 619,050 cubic yards of dredge material
 - Dredge material will raise 1,333,454sf of lots on North Beach by 2 to 4 feet
 - 100,000,000 gallons of salt water
 - 6,387 feet in length
- Beach Landscape
 - 1.7 miles of irrigation
 - 200 new royal palms to be added to beach
- Parking
 - 600 surface parking spaces
 - 2 new garages totaling 1,200 spaces
- Transportation
 - 8 foot sidewalks
 - Two 600-foot canal bridges with 22-foot boat clearance
- Bird Islands
 - 873,464 cubic yards of dirt
 - 11,163 linear feet of 14-ft deep rip-rap stone
- Environmental
 - Wetlands likely revitalized with the addition of the canal
 - Mosquito reduction
 - Island habitats for birds and sea life
 - Beach erosion protection
